Section 9-1-1 (a) is amended by changing < the annual charge from Ninety-three Thousand Seven Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$93,717) to One Hundred Thirty Thousand Forty Eight Dollars (\$130,048) ... and test year from 2000 to 2014 >

Section 9-1-1 (a) is amended to read: For public fire protection service to the Village of Spencer, the annual charge shall be One Hundred Thirty Thousand Forty-eight Dollars (\$130,048) to cover the use of mains and hydrants up to and including the terminal hydrant and connection on each main exiting for the 2014 test year.




ORDINANCE NUMBER 9-1-2  
PRIVATE FIRE-PROTECTION SERVICE – SUBURBAN – F-2

The Village Board of the Village of Spencer, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


Section 9-1-2 (c) is amended by changing < Four Dollars (\$4.00) to Five and 95/100 Dollars >

Section 9-1-2 (c) is amended to read: A charge for the volume of water used for each fire, either through a tank supply or from hydrants, will be billed to the township or fire department using water at Five and 95/100 Dollars (\$5.95) per one thousand (1,000) gallons. A service charge, in addition to the water charge, shall be Twenty-five Dollar (\$25.00) per hydrant used.

Section 9-1-3 (a) is amended by adding < ...permanent or continuous... This service shall also include reasonable quantities of water used for testing check valves and other backflow prevention devices. > removing < ...(where same are connected permanently or continuously to the mains)...>


Section 9-1-3 (a) is amended to read: **Service.** This service shall consist of permanent or continuous unmetered connections to the main for the purpose of supplying water to private fire protection systems such as automatic sprinkler systems, standpipes, and private hydrants. This service shall also include reasonable quantities of water used for testing check valves and other backflow prevention devices.



The Village Board of the Village of Spencer, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 9-1-4 (a) is amended by changing < service charges >

Section 9-1-4 (a) is amended to read: **Monthly Service Charge:**

5/8- inch meter -	\$11.40


Section 9-1-4 (c) is amended by changing < ... Ten Dollar (\$10.00) to Twenty-five Dollar (\$25.00) ... >

Section 9-1-4 (c) is amended to read: **Billing.** Bills for water service are rendered monthly and become due and payable on the fifteenth of the month following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of three percent (3%) but not less than Fifty cents (50 cents) will be added to bills not paid within twenty (20) days of issuance. This one-time three percent (3%) late payment charge is applicable to all customers. The utility customer may be given a written notice that the bill is overdue no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment or satisfactory arrangement for payment is made within the next ten days, service may be disconnected pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. PSC 185. A Twenty-five Dollar (\$25.00) charge will be made for processing checks that have been returned for insufficient funds.


Section 9-1-4 (d) is amended by changing < existing Combined Metering paragraph to read as Rate File from the PSC Schedule No. Mg-1 >

Section 9-1-4 (d) is amended to read: **Combined Metering.** For a residential customer with more than one meter on a single service lateral, volumetric reading from all meters shall be combined for billing. For a nonresidential customer, volumetric readings may be combined for billing if the utility for its own convenience places more than one meter on a single water service lateral. Multiple meters placed for the purpose of identifying water not discharged into the sanitary sewer are not considered for utility convenience and may not be combined for billing. This requirement does not preclude the utility from combining readings where metering configurations support such an approach. Volumetric readings from individually metered separate service laterals may not be combined for billing purposes.

GENERAL WATER SERVICE – UNMETERED – UG-1


The Village Board of the Village of Spencer, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 9-1-6 (a) is amended by changing < existing paragraphs to read as Rate File from the PSC Schedule No. Ug-1 >


Section 9-1-6 (a) is amended to read: **Rate.** Service may be supplied temporarily on an unmetered basis where the utility cannot immediately install a water meter, including water used for construction. Unmetered service shall be billed the amount that would be charged to a metered residential customer using 3,000 gallons of water per month under Schedule Mg-1, including the service charge for a 5/8-inch meter. If the utility determines that the actual usage exceeds 3,000 gallons of water per month, an additional charge for the estimated excess usage shall be made accordingly to the rates under Schedule Mg-1.

This schedule applies only to customers with a 1-inch or smaller service connection. For customers with a larger service connection, the utility shall install a temporary meter and charges shall be based on the rates set forth under Schedule Mg-1.


The Village Board of the Village of Spencer, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 9-1-7 (b) is amended by changing < existing paragraph to read as Rate File from the PSC Schedule No. Mpa-1 >


Section 9-1-7 (b) is amended to read: **Metered Service.** Water used by the Village of Spencer on an intermittent basis for flushing sewers, street washing, flooding skating rinks, drinking fountains, etc., shall be metered and billed according to the rates set forth in Schedule Mg-1.

Section 9-1-7 (c) is created to read: **Unmetered Service.** Where it is impossible to meter the service, the utility shall estimate the volume of water used based on the pressure, size of opening, and the period of time water is used. The estimated quantity shall be billed at the volumetric rates set forth in Schedule Mg-1, excluding any service charges.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 9-1-11  
BULK WATER – BW-1

The Village Board of the Village of Spencer, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 9-1-11 (a) is amended by removing < ..., or at the direction of the utility, estimated ... > adding < ...or estimated by the utility... > removing <... utility-approved party...> adding <...a party approved by the utility...>

Section 9-1-11 (a) is amended to read: All bulk water supplied from the water system through hydrants or other connections shall be metered or estimated by the utility. Utility personnel or a party approved by the utility shall supervise the delivery of water.

Section 9-1-11 (b) is amended by changing < \$4.00 to \$5.95 >

Section 9-1-11 (b) is amended to read:

- (1) Service Charge                    \$25.00
- (2) Plus Volume Charge            \$5.95 per 1,000 gallons


Section 9-1-11 (c) is created to read: **Bulk water Sales are:**

- 1 Water supplied by tank trucks or from hydrants for the purpose of extinguishing fires outside the utility's service area;
- 2 Water supplied by tank trucks from hydrants for purposes other than extinguishing fires, such as water used for irrigation or filling swimming pools; or,
- 3 Water supplied from hydrants or other temporary connections for general service type applications, except that Schedule Ug-1 applies for water supplied for construction purposes.


Section 9-1-11 (d) is created to read: A service charge of \$25.00 and a charge for the volume of water used shall be billed to the party using the water. The volumetric charge shall be calculated using the highest volumetric rate for residential customers under Schedule Mg-1. In addition, the meters that are assigned to bulk water customers for more than 7 days, the applicable service charge in Schedule Mg-1 will apply after the first 7 days.

The water utility may require a reasonable deposit for the temporary use of its equipment under this and other rate schedules. The deposit(s) collected shall be refunded upon return of the utility's equipment. Damaged or lost equipment shall be repaired or replaced at the customer's expense.


