September 15, 2014

Meeting was called to order by President Frome at 6:30 pm

Roll Call:

Trustees Pokallus, Maurer, Schafer, Day, Hagen and Toufar were present

Minutes:

(Day)(Toufar) was carried to dispense the reading and approve the meeting minutes as printed

Citizen Comments:

Matt Bychinski inquired about citizens present as it relates to the printed minutes the reads "no citizens present," and it was proposed to read "no citizens commented"

Announcements:

Trustee Toufar read a thank you letter from Mueller Publishing, a company that produces a local phone book, acknowledging the narrative of Spencer's history that will be included in their upcoming 20th anniversary edition

Public Works Report:

Joe Scidmore reported on the hydrant flushing and mentioned that the snow removal equipment is becoming finalized. Joe also mentioned that he removed many non-residents from the compost facility. Thad will look into the creation of a sign that Trustee Hagen brought forth

Chris Helgestad reported that the flow, during the last rainstorm, increased to 1100 gallons per minute with total flow being 500,000 gallons per day. Chris cited this as an infiltration and inflow problem for the sewer collection system

Police Chief's Report:

Chief Shawn Bauer reported that he has received the check for the damaged squad car. He also mentioned that the Marathon County Sheriff's Department will be loaning a squad car to the village

Chief Bauer stated that he assisted the Marshfield Police Department during an incident with trespassers on a train. Shawn also reported on the train that parked across the E Willow Dr. crossing for 25 ½ hours

Joe Scidmore inquired about hanging Christmas decorations at the same time that flags are taken down
